AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY22

Composting and Food Waste Reduction Pilot Projects FUNDS, AWARDED BY U S Department of Agriculture/Natural Resources Conservation.

WHEREAS, the U S Department of Agriculture/Natural Resources Conservation, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Public Works Department; and
