AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Save America's Treasures FUNDS, AWARDED BY National Park Service.

WHEREAS, the National Park Service, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Historic Preservation; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHT DOLLARS **(\$251,708.00)** would fund an archaeological assemblage that was excavated from the Parker-Harris Pottery Site in Boston's Charlestown neighborhood, for personal and maintenance costs on collections currently housed at the Archaeology Laboratory, and consultant's fee.
