TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of FOUR MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN DOLLARS **(\$4,460,897.00)** in the form of a grant, the FFY24 Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant Program, awarded by the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development to be administered by the Mayor's Office of Housing.

The grant would fund abatement, inspection, risk assessment, temporary relocation, and interim control of lead-based paint hazards in eligible privately owned, single-family and multi-family housing units that are occupied by low-income families.

I urge your Honorable Body to adopt this Order so that the City of Boston may accept the funds expeditiously and expend them upon award for the purposes for which they are granted.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND the FFY24 Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development.

WHEREAS, the the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Mayor's Office of Housing; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FOUR MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN DOLLARS **(\$4,460,897.00)** would fund abatement, inspection, risk assessment, temporary relocation, and interim control of lead-based paint hazards in eligible privately owned, single-family and multi-family housing units that are occupied by low-income families. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development, the FFY24 Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant Program award not to exceed the amount of FOUR MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN DOLLARS **(\$4,460,897.00)**.
