APPROVAL OF THE MARCH 18, 2026 CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2% to be given in July of each fiscal year of the contract term, as well as a \$1/hr flat increase in January, 2026 and a \$0.70/hr flat increase (for assigned monitors only) in January, 2028.
