WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong Commission; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTEEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$2,316,369.00) would fund nutrition services for older adults in the City of Boston. Therefore be it
