TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith a supplemental appropriation Order for the Boston Police Department for FY24 in the amount of sixty thousand, three hundred twenty nine dollars (\$60,329) to cover the FY24 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and the Boston Police Cadets Association. The terms of the contracts are October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2023. The major provisions of the contract include base wage increases of 2%, 2%, 1.5% and 2%, to be given in January of each fiscal year of the contract term.

As originally presented to you, the FY24 budget request included a Reserve for Collective Bargaining - a separate appropriation to fund projected collective bargaining increases. A separate order has been filed to reduce that appropriation to support this supplemental request.

I respectfully request your support of this supplemental appropriation.
