#### TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

As the local election official for the City of Boston, I request and recommend that the city hold in-person early voting for both the September 9, 2025, Preliminary Municipal Election (presuming this body acts favorably on my separate submission related to the date of the Preliminary) and the November 4, 2025, Municipal Election. I make this request in accordance with the provisions of G.L. c. 54, § 25B (c)(1) upon the request of the registrars of the City of Boston. That statute provides a local option to allow for in-person early voting for any Preliminary or Municipal Election.

It has been demonstrated that the combination of Vote-by-Mail and in-person early voting can increase turnout and reduce congestion on Election Day, making the act of casting a ballot and participating in democracy more accessible and manageable for both poll workers and voters.

All locations to be designated as early voting sites will be centrally located, in suitable and convenient publicly accessible buildings. In accordance with statutory requirements, the Election Department will publish notices of the early voting locations, dates, and hours at least 48 weekday hours before the early voting period begins.

Early voting hours will be set as follows (sites to be determined);
