AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY23 Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Prevention Grant Program (COPPGP) FUNDS, AWARDED BY U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND THIRTY-ONE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (**\$260,031.75**) would fund and support the installation of CO alarms and training and public education programs to promote health and public safety. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, FY23 Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Prevention Grant Program (COPPGP) award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND THIRTY-ONE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (**\$260,031.75**).
