### RESOLUTION TO SCHEDULE A WEEKLY COUNCIL MEETING FOR WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2024

**WHEREAS:** According to the latest citywide property assessment results published last Wednesday, it is now clear that the Boston City Council previously voted on property tax legislation based on inaccurate data provided to the body; *and*

**WHEREAS:** Now that more accurate data has been provided, it is necessary for the City Council to conduct a full hearing with expert and public testimony and to vote accordingly; *and*

**WHEREAS:** The taxpayers of Boston expect their elected officials to perform their due diligence on this controversial home rule petition, especially as it relates to tax data and calculations. It is now necessary for the City Council to add another weekly Council Meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2024; *and*

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

That the Boston City Council supports adding an additional Council Meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2024 to discuss the latest citywide property assessment results.
