I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE MILLION FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$1,056,840.00) in the form of a grant, State FY22 Council On Aging formula grant, awarded by MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs to be administered by the Age Strong.

The grant would fund services for 88,070 older adults in the City of Boston at \$12 per person, according to the 2020 Census.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND State FY22 Council On Aging formula grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs.

WHEREAS, the MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$1,056,840.00) would fund services for 88,070 older adults in the City of Boston at \$12 per person, according to the 2020 Census. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, State FY22 Council On Aging formula grant award not to exceed the amount of ONE MILLION FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$1,056,840.00).
