RESOLUTION HONORING BARBADOS' 58TH INDEPENDENCE DAY AND FLAG RAISING

WHEREAS: November 30 marks the 58th anniversary of Barbados' Independence Day; and

WHEREAS: Out of the 4,704 foreign-born Barbadians in Massachusetts, around 2,595 reside in

Boston. Barbados ranks as the 15th largest country of origin among Boston's foreign-born population, making up 1.5% of the city's total foreign-born residents. Over

half of Barbadians in Massachusetts call Boston home; and

WHEREAS: The Barbadian community has significantly enriched and enhanced the cultural, social,

and economic tapestry of the City of Boston through various facets including business,

sports, politics, education, dance, literature, and the arts; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That on November 29, 2024, in commemoration of Barbados' 58th Independence Day, the Boston City Council directed the Property Management Department to proudly raise the Barbados flag on the third flagpole at City Hall Plaza in place of the City of Boston flag.
