The terms of the contracts are September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2022 and September 1, 2022 to August 31, 2024. The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2%, 2.5%, 2.5% and 2.5%, to be given in September of each fiscal year of the contract term, as well as other cost items including inclusion reform implementation.
