I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (**\$6,460.00**) in the form of a grant, Federal FY22 Senior Companion Program, awarded by Corporation for National and Community Service to be administered by the Age Strong.

The grant would fund reimbursement for travel and meals, plus stipends. This supplemental award represents a mandatory increase in the stipend from \$3.00 to \$3.15 per hour, effective July 1, 2022.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Federal FY22 Senior Companion Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY Corporation for National and Community Service.

WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (**\$6,460.00**) would fund reimbursement for travel and meals, plus stipends. This supplemental award represents a mandatory increase in the stipend from \$3.00 to \$3.15 per hour, effective July 1, 2022. Therefore be it
