RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF UNITE HERE LOCAL 26 HYATT CENTRIC HOTEL WORKERS TO GET A FIRST CONTRACT

- WHEREAS:** The hotel workers at the Magna Hospitality-owned Hyatt Centric Faneuil Hall joined UNITE HERE Local 26 in March 2021; *and*
- WHEREAS:** UNITE HERE Local 26 represents thousands of workers at dozens of hotels in Boston; *and*
- WHEREAS:** Most of the Hyatt Centric hotel workers earn four dollars less per hour than union hotel workers at other hotels; *and*
- WHEREAS:** Most of the Hyatt Centric hotel workers are not on the employer-sponsored health insurance; *and*
- WHEREAS:** The Hyatt Centric has not agreed to fair work rules like daily room cleaning; *and*
- WHEREAS:** The Hyatt Centric hotel workers are asking for similar wages, benefits, and working conditions as other union workers who do similar work at other hotels; *and*
- WHEREAS:** After over a year of bargaining, Magna Hospitality and the workers represented by UNITE HERE Local 26 have not yet reached an agreement; *and*
- WHEREAS:** Hyatt Centric workers have begun conducting picket lines in front of the hotel;
NOW

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the Boston City Council go on record expressing support for the efforts of the UNITE HERE Local 26 members at the Magna Hospitality-owned Hyatt Centric Faneuil Hall in their efforts to reach a contract with similar wages, benefits and conditions as at other union hotels and honor the workers' efforts by joining all picket lines; *and*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the General Manager of the Hyatt Centric Faneuil Hall.
