AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND The Solar Recommissioning Project grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Department of Energy Resources.

WHEREAS, the MA Department of Energy Resources, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Environment; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$189,000.00**) would fund the replacement of existing inverters with newer models, the incorporation of rapid shutdown modules to meet safety regulations, the replacement of the monitoring system, and proper redressing of wiring.
