I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$148,824.00) in the form of a grant, the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Reallocation, awarded by United States Department Of Justice, passed through the MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, to be administered by the Police Department.

The grant would fund the Annual Boston Address Verification procedures mandated by the Massachusetts Sex Offender Registry Board.

I urge your Honorable Body to adopt this Order so that the City of Boston may accept the funds expeditiously and expend them upon award for the purposes for which they are granted.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Reallocation FUNDS, AWARDED BY United States Department Of Justice AND MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security.

WHEREAS, the United States Department Of Justice and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$148,824.00) would fund the Annual Boston Address Verification procedures mandated by the Massachusetts Sex Offender Registry Board. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the United States Department Of Justice, and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security' the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Reallocation award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS **(\$148,824.00)**.
