- **WHEREAS:** Bill Rodgers is an American runner, Olympian, four time Boston Marathon winner and four time New York City marathon winner; *and*
- WHEREAS: "Boston Billy" was inducted to the National Track and Field Hall of Fame in 1999 and inducted in the first round to the National Distance Running Hall of Fame in 199; and
