**RESOLUTION DECLARING MAY 26, 2026  
FRANTZDY PIERROT DAY**

**WHEREAS,** Frantzdy Pierrot was born and spent his childhood in Haiti before moving to Melrose, Massachusetts at the age of eleven, where he developed as a student-athlete, attended Melrose High School, and distinguished himself as a standout soccer player before continuing his collegiate career at Northeastern University and later Coastal Carolina University; *and*

**WHEREAS,** During his collegiate career, Pierrot earned recognition as one of the top players in his conference, helped lead his team to a conference championship, and built the foundation for a professional career that began in 2018 and has since taken him to clubs across Belgium, France, Israel, Greece, and Türkiye; *and*

**WHEREAS,** Through his rise in international football, Pierrot competed at one of the highest levels of club competition through the UEFA Champions League, while also achieving domestic success and establishing himself as one of Haiti's most accomplished footballers; *and*

**WHEREAS,** As a member of the Haitian Men's National Team, Les Grenadiers, Pierrot has become one of the leading goal scorers in the history of the national team and has proudly represented Haiti on the international stage; *and*

**WHEREAS,** Pierrot is expected to represent Haiti in the 2026 FIFA World Cup, marking the nation's first appearance in the tournament in fifty-two years, with Haiti's opening match scheduled to take place in Greater Boston on June 13, 2026, creating a meaningful connection between his Massachusetts roots and Haiti's return to the world stage; *and*

**WHEREAS,** Beyond his accomplishments on the field, Pierrot has worked to expand opportunities for future generations through the Frantzdy Pierrot Academy, which seeks to develop young athletes in Haiti by providing access to training, mentorship, structure, and opportunity through sport; *and*

**WHEREAS,** Frantzdy Pierrot's leadership, athletic achievements, and commitment to youth development have elevated Haitian excellence internationally and inspired young people in Haiti, Massachusetts, and throughout the Haitian diaspora; ***NOW, THEREFORE BE IT***

**RESOLVED:** That the Boston City Council hereby declare May 26, 2026 as Frantzdy Pierrot Day, in recognition of his achievements in sport, his service to youth, and his contributions as an ambassador for Haiti and the Haitian community, and extends its best wishes as Haiti heads to the FIFA World Cup stage.
