I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$1,485,264.20) in the form of a grant, the FY26 Hazardous Materials Response Team Earmark Grant, awarded by Massachusetts Department of Fire Services to be administered by the Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$1,485,264.20) would fund the needs of the Boston Fire Department Hazardous Materials Response Team, per line item 8000-0600 of the FY26 General Appropriations Act. ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services, the FY26 Hazardous Materials Response Team Earmark Grant award not to exceed the amount of ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$1,485,264.20).
