AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS AT SAINT JAMES STREET BORDERING COPLEY SQUARE.

ORDERED: That the City of Boston, acting by and through the Boston Parks and Recreation Department, be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to Section 53A1/2 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws to accept and expend a grant award in an amount not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$550,000.00) from the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority for sidewalk infrastructure improvements at Saint James Street near Copley Square.
