WHEREAS, the MA Department of Mental Health, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (**\$106,575.00**) would fund a full-time recovery coach/forensic peer specialist to assist BPD officers with Hub & Center of Responsibility meetings, citywide. Therefore be it
