His supreme sacrifice in defense of our country while on active duty as Major General with the U.S. Army in the Battle of Bunker Hill. Killed in action in Charlestown on June 14th, 1775. Born in the Roxbury neighborhood of Boston on June 11th, 1741 to mother Mary Warren and father Joseph Warren. General Warren is one of our nation's first veterans.
