AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Federal FY23 Senior Companion Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY Corporation for National and Community Service.

WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong Commission; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETEEN DOLLARS (**\$430,419.00**) would fund reimbursement for travel and meals, plus stipends, for volunteers who provide companionship to homebound and frail seniors. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Corporation for National and Community Service, Federal FY23 Senior Companion Program award not to exceed the amount of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETEEN DOLLARS (**\$430,419.00**).
