AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY22 First Responder Naloxone Administration Grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY Massachusetts Department of Public Health.

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$50,000.00**) would fund the purchase of Naloxone and related supplies for use by the Boston Police Department. Therefore be it
