AN EVENING OF REMEMBRANCE & HOPE

IN RECOGNITION OF:

October 7th, 2024 marks the first anniversary of the terrorist attack by Hamas on Israel. Over 1,200 civilians were killed that day, including 46 American Nationals. 254 civilians and foreign nationals were also taken hostage and, to date, an estimated 97 hostages remain abducted. On this solemn anniversary, we gather as a community to honor and remember the lives of those who were lost and call for the immediate release and safe return of the remaining hostages. We stand with our neighbors in the Jewish community and mourn alongside them during this difficult time. We stand united against antisemitism and hate. We continue to look to the future in hope of a world with more understanding, empathy, and peace.
