TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith a supplemental appropriation Order for the Parks and Recreation Department for FY23 in the amount of thirty two thousand, three hundred thirty four dollars (\$32,334) to cover the FY23 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and the Boston Park Rangers' Association. The terms of the contracts are July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023. The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2%, 1.5%, and 2%, to be given in October of each fiscal year of the contract term.

As originally presented to you, the FY23 budget request included a Reserve for Collective Bargaining - a separate appropriation to fund projected collective bargaining increases. A separate order has been filed to reduce that appropriation to support this supplemental request.

I respectfully request your support of this supplemental appropriation.
