AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND the Pipeline Emergency Response Grant (PERG) FUNDS, AWARDED BY United States Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of NINETY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX DOLLARS **(\$99,476.00)** would fund training for emergency responders in high-consequence areas to protect people, property, and the environment from accidents involving gas or hazardous liquid pipelines. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the United States Department of Transportation, the Pipeline Emergency Response Grant (PERG) award not to exceed the amount of NINETY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX DOLLARS **(\$99,476.00)**.
