AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Electric Stove Replacement Program (EJG2G) FUNDS, AWARDED BY United States Environmental Protection Agency.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Environment; and
