ORDER REQUESTING CERTAIN INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 17F RE: DETAINDER REQUESTS FROM JANUARY 1, 2024 TO THE PRESENT

ORDERED: That under the provisions of section 1.17F of Chapter 376 of the Acts of 1951 as amended by section 16 of Chapter 190 of the Acts of 1982, and any other applicable provision of law, the Mayor, be, and hereby is, requested to obtain and deliver to the City Council, within one week of the receipt hereof, the following information relative to

1. From January 1, 2024 to the present, provide any and all communication from any federal government agency to the Boston Police Department or any City department about detainer requests, any cooperation agreements, and/or Memorandum of Understanding.
2. From January 1, 2024 to the present, how many detainer requests were requested, the reason for the request, and how the Boston Police responded to it.
3. On the January 1, 2024 to present detainer requests, what were the specific reasons to request to detain, including if this accounted for open criminal cases. If so, please include these open criminal cases.
