I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS **(\$1,150,000.00)** in the form of a grant, a comprehensive, inter-agency strategy that connects law enforcement, employment, education, public health and youth development agencies to reduce youth violence in the Commonwealth. This additional funding increases the total grant to \$2,300,000 over two years, awarded by MA Executive Office of Health and Human Services to be administered by the Police Department.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND a comprehensive, inter-agency strategy that connects law enforcement, employment, education, public health and youth development agencies to reduce youth violence in the Commonwealth. This additional funding increases the total grant to \$2,300,000 over two years FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

WHEREAS, the MA Executive Office of Health and Human Services, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$1,150,000.00**) would fund FY22 and FY23 Safe and Successful Youth Initiative Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the MA Executive Office of Health and Human Services, a comprehensive, inter-agency strategy that connects law enforcement, employment, education, public health and youth development agencies to reduce youth violence in the Commonwealth. This additional funding increases the total grant to \$2,300,000 over two years award not to exceed the amount of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$1,150,000.00**).
