AN ORDER TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND PARKLAND ACQUISITIONS AND RENOVATIONS FOR COMMUNITIES (PARC) PROGRAM GRANT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$425,000) FOR THE RENOVATION OF RONAN PARK.

ORDERED: That the Commissioner of the Parks and Recreation Department, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized pursuant to Section 53A1/2 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs (EOEEA), Division of Conservation Services' Parkland Acquisitions and Renovations for Communities (PARC) Program grant award in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$425,000.00). The funds will provide capital improvements to Ronan Park located in the neighborhood of Dorchester.

FURTHER ORDERED: That the City of Boston, in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 45 Section 3 and the City's authority under Chapter 185 Section 3 of the Acts of 1875, hereby confirms that Ronan Park is permanently dedicated for park and playground purposes, as required by EOEEA for parks receiving PARC Grant assistance.

THE FORGOING, IF PASSED IN THE ABOVE FORM, WILL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.
