**ORDER REQUESTING CERTAIN INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 17F:
REGARDING THE USE OF \$558.7 MILLION IN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT
(ARPA) FUNDS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON**

ORDERED: That under the provisions of section 1.17F of Chapter 376 of the Acts of 1951 as amended by section 16 of Chapter 190 of the Acts of 1982, and any other applicable provision of law, the Mayor, be, and hereby is, requested to obtain and deliver to the City Council, within one week of the receipt hereof, the following information relative to

1. Confirmation as to the existence of any instances of possible misuse of funds from the \$558.7 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) federal grant funding from the United States Treasury and reported to the City of Boston or the Office of Economic Opportunity and Inclusion, including any nonprofit funding that was either returned or requested to be returned for any reason.
2. Whether the City of Boston communicated with any organization that received these grants to return the funds back to the city.
