Your dedication and advocacy to improving the quality of life in Chinatown and the Leather District, especially in the ever-important issue of heat resiliency. Chinatown is one of the city's hottest neighborhoods due to the urban heat island effect and its lack of trees and green space.

Unlike neighborhoods with large parks, Chinatown has only small park parcels, making an expanded tree canopy essential for providing shade, cooling the air, and reducing stormwater runoff. Chinatown and the Leather District also experience some of the state's worst air pollution because of its proximity to the Mass Pike and I-93, contributing to high rates of asthma and other respiratory illnesses. Rising temperatures further worsen air quality, making investments to reduce the heat island effect especially important. We appreciate your attention to this critical issue and your commitment to creating healthier, more resilient neighborhoods. Let us recommit ourselves to advancing environmental and economic justice in Chinatown, the Leather District, and throughout the City of Boston.
