AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Open Data Curriculum FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Department of Education.

WHEREAS, the MA Department of Education, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Dpt of Innovation & Technology; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$500,000.00**) would fund the development of a curriculum that can be used by teachers in Boston Public Schools, as well as other educational providers that leverage existing open data from the city, state, and federal government. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the MA Department of Education, Open Data Curriculum award not to exceed the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$500,000.00**).
