ORDER OF COUNCILOR ERIN MURPHY

ORDERED: That under the provisions of Section 17F of Chapter 452 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, and any other applicable provision of law, Her Honor, the Mayor, be, and hereby is, requested to obtain and deliver to the City Council, within one week of the receipt hereof, the following information:

Information regarding all grant programs, contracts, and funding provided to nonprofit organizations, community-based organizations, and external partners in Fiscal Year 2026 and Fiscal Year 2027, including all reductions, eliminations, and changes in funding.

A comprehensive list of all such programs by department, including Fiscal Year 2026 and Fiscal Year 2027 funding amounts.

A list of all nonprofit organizations and external partners that received funding in Fiscal Year 2025, Fiscal Year 2026 and Fiscal Year 2027, including identification of those with reduced funding, eliminated funding, or level or increased funding.

A list of all City departments that reduced or eliminated funding to external partners, and the specific programs affected.

All guidance, directives, and communications provided to City departments regarding identifying and implementing budget reductions prior to submission of the Fiscal Year 2027 budget, including departmental responses and proposed reductions.

A list of all programs and services that will no longer be provided in Fiscal Year 2027 as a result of these funding changes.

Information identifying any positions eliminated as a result of these funding changes, including positions within City departments and those supported through contracts or grants.

This request follows prior Requests for Information and budget hearings in which this information was requested but not provided, as well as testimony during the Fiscal Year 2027 Operating Budget hearing in which, in response to this request, Ashley Groffenberger and James Williamson stated on the record, **“Yes, we can certainly do that.”** This Order is intended to formalize that request and ensure timely delivery of the information.

Requesting that the Mayor, the Office of Budget Management, and all relevant City departments provide any and all information available regarding this matter, including summary tables and electronically usable data where possible.
