A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Boston was held in the Christopher A. Iannella Chamber, Boston City Hall on March 23, 2022 at 12:10 P.M.

President Flynn in the Chair. All Councilors Present.

Reverend Eugene Rivers, Azusa Christian Community, delivered the invocation and the meeting was opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

President Flynn moved to adopt the minutes from the March 16, 2022 meeting. Motion prevailed.

The term of the contract is July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023. The major provisions of the contract include base wage increases of 2% , 1.5% and 2% to be given in October of each fiscal year of the contract term.
