I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of **FOURTEEN MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$14,400,000.00)** in the form of a grant, Safe Streets and Roads for all, awarded by US DOT- National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, passed through the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, to be administered by the Transportation Department.

The grant would fund systemic safety improvements to traffic signals at 50 locations across the City.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Safe Streets and Roads for all FUNDS, AWARDED BY US DOT-National Highway Traffic Safety Administration AND Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the US DOT-National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and Massachusetts Department of Transportation, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FOURTEEN MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$14,400,000.00**) would fund systemic safety improvements to traffic signals at 50 locations across the City. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the US DOT-National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, and Massachusetts Department of Transportation' Safe Streets and Roads for all award not to exceed the amount of FOURTEEN MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$14,400,000.00**).
