I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,620,752.00) in the form of a grant, State FY24 Council on Aging formula allocation, awarded by MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs to be administered by the Age Strong Commission.

The grant would fund social and health care services for 115,768 older adults in the City of Boston at \$14 per person, according to 2020 Census data from UMass Boston Donahue Institute.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND State FY24 Council on Aging formula allocation FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs.

**WHEREAS**, the MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong Commission; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,620,752.00) would fund social and health care services for 115,768 older adults in the City of Boston at \$14 per person, according to 2020 Census data from UMass Boston Donahue Institute.
