I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$441,825.00) in the form of a grant, FY22 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant - Local Allocation, awarded by United States Department Of Justice to be administered by the Police Department.
