AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND the Moakley Park FEMA BRIC grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY Federal Emergency Management Agency AND Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency and Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Parks & Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of EIGHT HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$819,000.00) would fund a program which aims to shift the federal focus away from reactive disaster spending and toward research-supported, proactive investment in community resilience. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency' the Moakley Park FEMA BRIC grant award not to exceed the amount of EIGHT HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$819,000.00).
