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**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND MHC FY23 Survey and Planning grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY United States Department of the Interior AND Massachusetts Historical Commission.**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of the Interior and Massachusetts Historical Commission, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Office of Historic Preservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$38,000.00**) would fund surveys that compile historical and architectural information about buildings in East Boston. Therefore be it
