AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY 2023 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY Federal Emergency Management Agency.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS AND NINETY CENTS (\$1,202,560.90) would fund critically needed resources that equip and train emergency personnel to recognized standards, enhance operational efficiencies, foster interoperability, and support community resilience.
