I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY-EIGHT CENTS (**\$2,299,117.68**) in the form of a grant, FY23 State Elder Lunch Program, awarded by MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs to be administered by the Age Strong.

**WHEREAS**, the MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY-EIGHT CENTS **(\$2,299,117.68)** would fund nutrition services for older adults in the City of Boston, at a rate of \$7.39 per meal for up to 311,112 meals. Therefore be it
