## IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY ONE

## **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CBC 2-8.3**

Be it ordained by the City Council of Boston, as follows:

That the City of Boston Code be amended as follows:

Section 1. CBC 2-8.3 For the conduct of the affairs of the City Council there shall be, in addition to the City Clerk, a Central Staff Director and other such subordinate officers as may be appointed by a majority of the City Council from time to time. Such Central Staff Director and subordinate officers shall perform such duties as the Council may provide by order from time to time, and they shall receive an annual salary determined by Council order from within the salary ranges below:

Administration & Technical Assistant	\$52,250 -\$75,250

The City Council President may designate a Central Staff member to serve in the capacity of Deputy Central Staff Director and may award a stipend.

For the conduct of the affairs of the City Council, in addition to the Central Staff Director and subordinate officers provided for, there shall be administrative assistants and secretaries to be appointed from time to time by the City Council. Each Councilor's office shall receive Three Hundred Three Thousand One Hundred Forty Two (\$303,142) Dollars per year and the President's office shall receive Three Hundred

Sixty Six Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Eight (\$366,598) Dollars per year to pay such salaries according to the rules of the City Council.
