**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and MA Executive Office of Elder Affairs, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Age Strong; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$177,271.00) would fund consumer protection programs to improve long-term services for older adults in the City of Boston. Therefore be it
