SQUARE AT THE INTERSECTION OF GLEN ROAD AND  
FOREST HILLS STREET IN JAMAICA PLAIN IN MEMORY  
OF PAUL XAVIER HOGAN

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan was born September, 29th 1918 in Jamaica Plain, Massachusetts; **and**

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan is the son of William P. and Marion E. Hogan; **and**

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan was Cousin to Michael Taylor; **and**

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan began active duty in the U.S. Army Air Corps on August 12th, 1943, during World War II; **and**

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan served 701th Bomb Squadron, 445th Bomb GP; **and**

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Paul X. Hogan died honorably in action on February 27th, 1945; **and**
