with using Boston's population data to redraw districts; and

WHEREAS: The redistricting process will require substantial community input and

participation and the Boston City Council should make every effort to ensure that

the process is open, transparent, and accessible; NOW THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED: That the appropriate committee of the Boston City Council hold a hearing to

discuss the redistricting process in the City of Boston; and that representatives from the Department of Intergovernmental Relations, the US Census Bureau, the

Secretary of the Commonwealth, and other interested parties be invited.
