WHEREAS, the United States Department Of Justice, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS **(\$239,254.00)** would fund two Criminalist positions, overtime, lab supplies, and continuing education expenses. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the the United States Department Of Justice, FY2020 DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction Program award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$239,254.00).
