A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Boston was held in the Christopher A. Iannella Chamber, City Hall on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 at 12:17 P.M.

President Flynn in the Chair. Absent Councilor Worrell.

Reverend Art J. Gordon, St. John Missionary Baptist Church, delivered the invocation and the meeting was opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
